



India and Its Neighbour

India shares border with many countries. India's neighbouring countries are

1. **Pakistan** in the North-West portion
2. **China** in the North region
3. **Nepal** is just above the central regions
4. **Bhutan** in the North-East region
5. **Bangladesh** near the eastern side, formed in 1971
6. **Myanmar** (Burma) in the far eastern side
7. **Afghanistan** in the Northern region sharing a small boundary with India
8. **Sri Lanka** in the Southern region, separated from India by Palk Strait

Length of Borders with Neighbouring Countries

India shares longest boundary with Bangladesh (4096 km), followed by China (3488 km) and Pakistan (3323 km).

Indian States situated on International Borders

There are many states of India which are situated along international borders adjacent to neighbouring countries and they are

Pakistan	4	Gujarat, Rajasthan, Punjab and Jammu and Kashmir
Afghanistan	1	Jammu and Kashmir
China	5	Jammu and Kashmir, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Sikkim and Arunachal Pradesh
Nepal	5	Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Bihar, West Bengal, Sikkim
Bhutan	4	Sikkim, West Bengal, Assam and Arunachal Pradesh
Bangladesh	5	West Bengal, Assam, Meghalaya, Tripura and Mizoram.

Redcliffe Line (1947)	India and Pakistan
LoC (Line of Control)	India and Pakistan (Kashmir)
McMahon Line (1914)	India and China
Durand Line (1896)	Pakistan and Afghanistan
Palk Strait	India and Sri Lanka
